Does age affect their poop time?

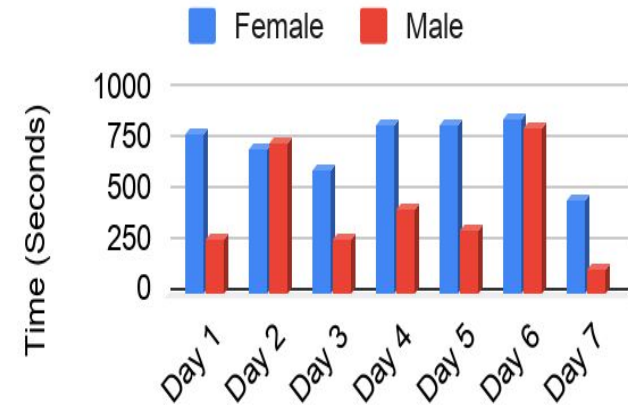

Multiplication, division & addition

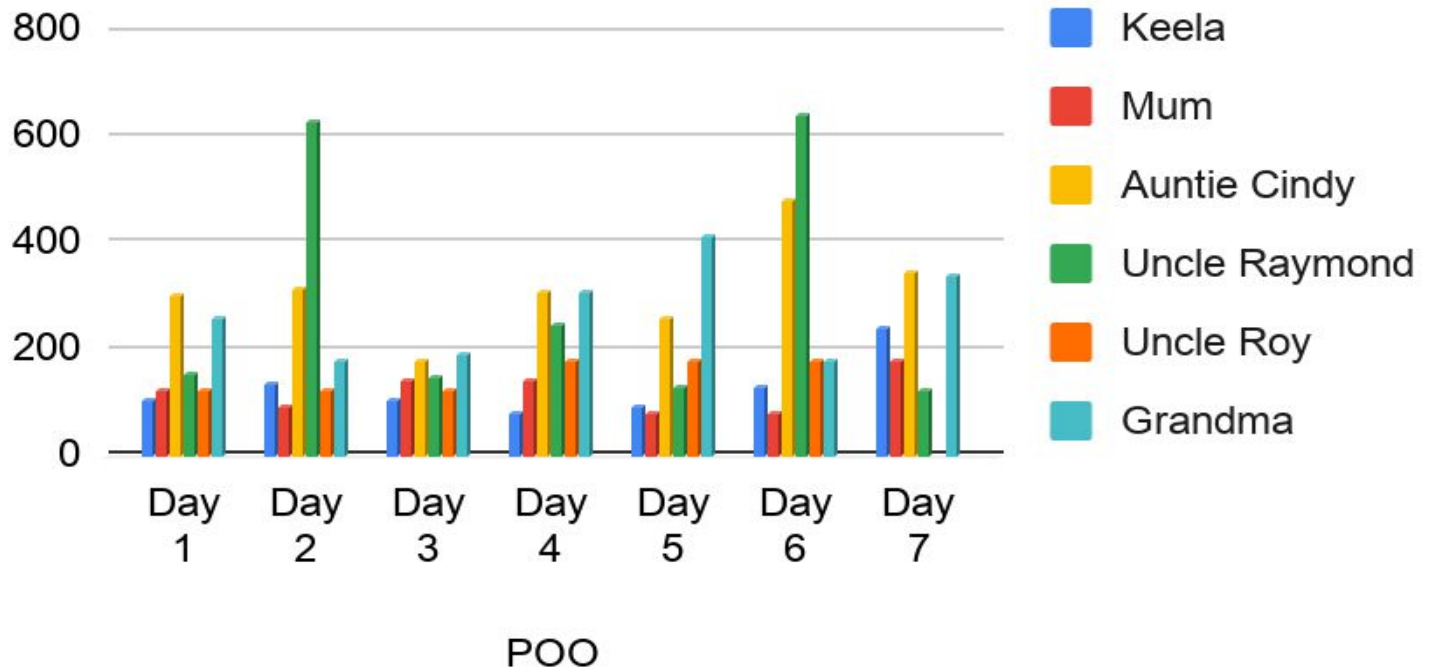


How I figured out the average



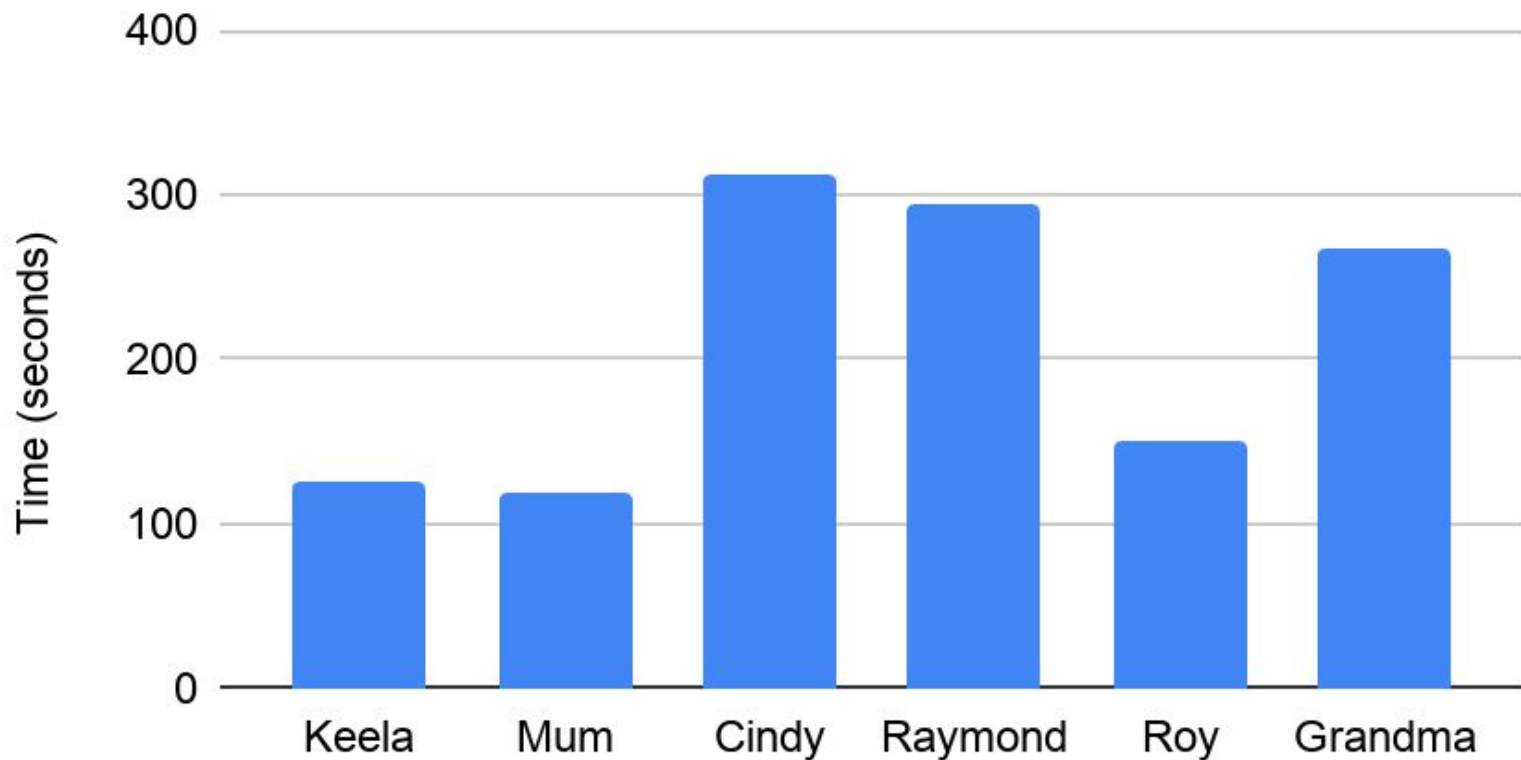
First, I asked my relatives to time their poo. After that I went on google sheets and made the graphs.

Daily Time



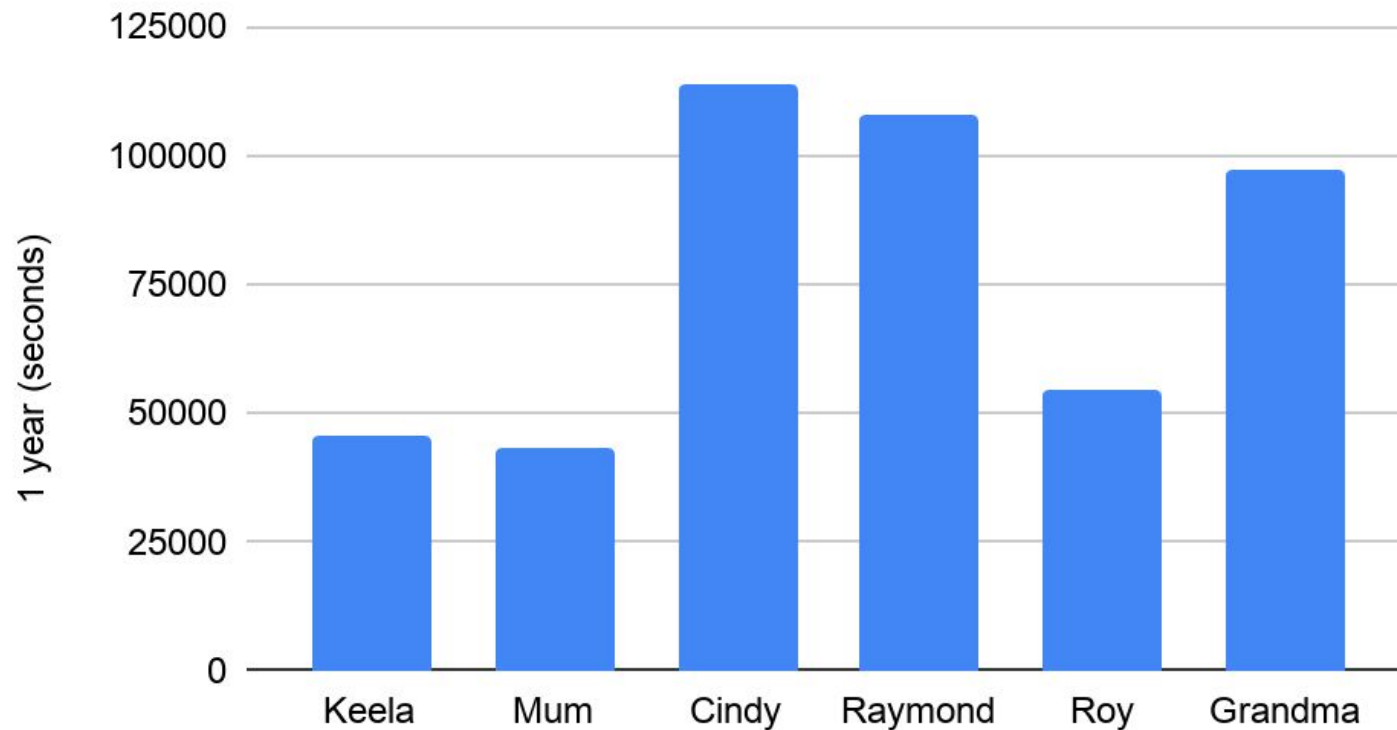
Then I made a graph on everyone's daily individual average in seconds.

Daily Individual average time



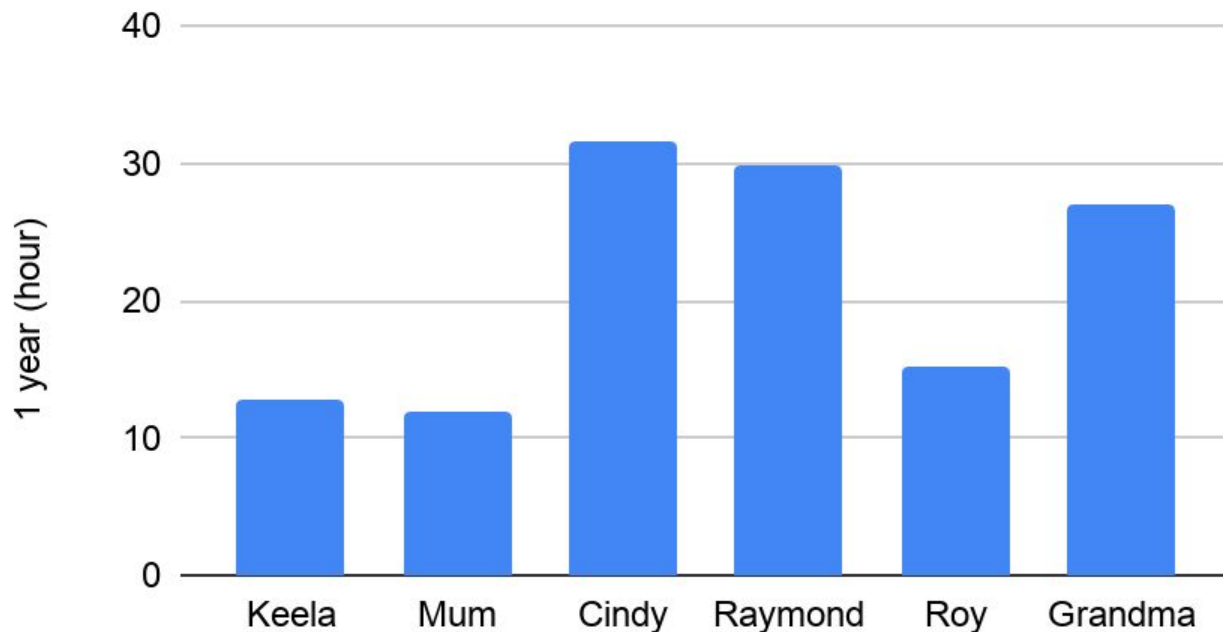
Then I did everyone's average for a year (seconds)
